

Confined Space Hazard Assessment

Hazard Identification – “Recognize/Report it”

For both confined space and restricted spaces it is the responsibility of the workers to complete a pre-job Hazard Assessment to assess the task at hand, the risks of the task, and what precautions must be taken to reduce or eliminate the risk. The hazard assessment needs to be revised whenever there is evidence to indicate it is no longer valid. Any task involving a Confined Space Entry, in addition to the hazard assessment, a Confined Space Permit must be prepared by a competent person to ensure that the risk of working in the Confined Space is minimized before any worker enters the space.
